Present: None for petitioner.
None for driver cum owner. **(already ex parte and defence struck off vide order dated 20.05.2022).**
Offending vehicle is uninsured.
Ahlmad from the court of Ld. MM.

Report filed by the Ahland as FDR was not kept at the time of releasing the vehicle on superdari. It is seen that as per the reply filed by ASI Jai Bhagwan, he did not give any objection before the court of Ld MM regarding vehicle being uninsured. **Accordingly, notice be issued to ASI Jai Bhagwan No. 628/OND for next date of hearing directing him to appear in person.**

No report received regarding disability certificate. Application has been filed on behalf of petitioner stating that fresh disability certificate be issued as the name of petitioner has been mentioned differently in DAR, MLC and Aadhar Card. Accordingly, **fresh directions are issued to conduct disability examination of petitioner/injured namely Hashu Bibi @ Haso @ Hanshu Bibi.**

Application of injured/petitioner seeking necessary directions to the concerned hospital for issuance of disability certificate has been filed.

Submissions Heard. Record perused.

In view of the submissions, MS, B.S.A. Hospital, Rohini, Delhi, is directed to constitute a board of doctors consisting of atleast 3 doctors to assess the disability if any, suffered by the injured in the accident and file the report regarding the nature and extent of disability suffered by him. The report along with 3 spare copies to be sent within 2 months. The petitioner is

directed to report to the concerned hospital, alongwith complete medical treatment record alongwith self-attested copy copies of his medical treatment

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record including MLC with dasti copy of this order on **10.06.2024 at 11.00 AM. In case Disability Board shall not examine the injured/patient on the aforesaid date, Chairperson of the Disability Board is directed to give the next date in writing to the petitioner/injured for examination.**

It is hereby directed that the concerned hospital shall make arrangements to send the Disability Certificate/Report to this Tribunal directly through a responsible officer, who will appear alongwith report and relevant record(s), so that his statement could be recorded on the same day.

Application is disposed of accordingly.

Dasti allowed.

Last opportunity is granted to the petitioner to appear before the hospital for examination.

Put up for report as well as ex parte evidence on **27.09.2024.**
