ORDER

Reply on behalf of State has been filed. Heard on the bail application for regular bail of the applicant in **FIR No. 104 dated 13.06.2025, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, P.S. Amloh.**

2. Allegation against **applicant-accused Deen Dayal @ Pattu** is that in the area which falls under the jurisdiction of **Police Station Amloh**, accused-applicant was apprehended on the basis of suspicion. From the conscious possession of accused-applicant **160 intoxicant tablets of Alprazolam 0.5** were recovered. The recovery of **160 intoxicant tablets of Alprazolam 0.5** which was effected from the accused-applicant falls under non commercial quantity. The applicant/accused is in custody since **13.06.2025** i.e. for **about two months**. The presentation of challan in Court and trial thereof will take considerable time. Recovery has already been effected. So, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicants/accused in judicial custody for an indefinite period. As such, the accused-applicant **Deen Dayal @ Pattu** is ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/-, with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions that accused-applicant shall appear in Court on each and every

date of hearing; he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court; he will not commit any offence similar to the one alleged to be committed in this case and he will not interfere with prosecution evidence in any manner. Bail application stands allowed accordingly. Papers be attached with main file/remand papers.
