Bail application received by entrustment. It be registered. Heard. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant has contended that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The applicant has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. Moreover, the name of the applicant is not mentioned in the FIR. The applicant is ready to join the investigation and undertake to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by this court. Lastly, prayer has been made for acceptance of the bail application.

From these submission of the learned counsel for the applicant and without commenting upon merits of the case at this stage, custodial interrogation of present applicant is not required, ends of justice shall be met in case applicant is directed to join the investigation within seven days and assist the investigating officer/S.H.O. of concerned police station as and when called. Upon his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of I.O./SHO. He shall comply with the provisions of section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Let notice of bail application be issued to the State and to come up on 13.02.2019 for awaiting police report.
