Heard. In this case, accused/applicant Boota Singh was granted interim anticipatory bail with a direction to him to join investigation within seven days and assist the Investigating Officer/SHO of the concerned police station, vide order dated 05.02.2019. Today, ASI Manjit Singh has suffered statement in the court that accused/applicant has joined the investigation but he is not cooperating in the investigation as recovery of mobile phones is still to be effected from him and his custodial interrogation is required. Learned Addl.P.P. for the State has contended that more than 100 mobile phones are to be recovered from the accused/applicant. No plausible explanation has been furnished by the accused/applicant for not cooperating in the investigation. Since the accused/applicant has failed to comply with the directions given to him while granting interim bail and has not cooperated in the investigation, therefore, he is not entitled to extraordinary and discretionary relief of anticipatory bail. Therefore, present anticipatory bail is hereby dismissed. Record be returned and the file of bail application be consigned to record room.
