ORDER

Arguments on bail application instituted on behalf of applicant in the afore-mentioned FIR addressed. Police record produced. SCT-Bikramjit Singh produced his report. Remand papers pending before this court for 31.07.2026 annexed.

Heard. Perusal of police record so produced before the court reveals registration of FIR on dated 04.06.2026 on apprehension of accused Jagdeep Singh @ Chuhi in possession of 06 gram heroin and ₹500/- drug money. During the course of investigation, accused Jagdeep Singh @ Chuhi has suffered disclosure statement vide which he has disclosed that the afore-mentioned contraband has been procured by him from Gurjant Singh @ Jantu and Akashdeep Singh @ Akash (applicant). Accordingly, they were nominated as co-accused.

Consequent upon apprehension of applicant on the same day, itself, no further recovery was effected from him. Admittedly, alleged recovery effected from main accused falls under the category of 'non-commercial quantity'. The investigating agency is yet to collect any evidence either through call details record or otherwise to establish link of applicant with co-accused Jagdeep Singh @ Chuhi. It is evident that culmination of investigation and presentation of challan shall take time. Whereas, no useful purpose would be served by retaining applicant/accused behind the bars any more. In the aforementioned backdrop, instant bail application stands allowed. Applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. In accordance with directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Police Strategy for Grant of Bail (SC)**, Law Finder Doc ID # **2118055**, concerned Ahlmad is directed to send soft copy of order by email for its delivery to the applicant through concerned Jail Superintendent, positively by tomorrow. He is further directed to obtain screen-shot of email sent and place on file. The concerned Jail Superintendent is directed to enter the date of grant of bail in the e-prisons software or any other software which is being used by the Prison Department. Police record be returned. Bail application file be attached with the remand papers pending before this court.
