ORDER

1. Record of learned trial court has been received.
2. Heard.
3. The police of Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh has registered the FIR against the accused/applicant under Section 279, 337, 338 of IPC, as the accused/applicant have drove Innova Car bearing registration No.PB-23G-0212 in a rash and negligent manner, which caused simple as well as grievous hurt to Raj Kumar Bali. The report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. was presented in the court and charge was framed against the accused/applicant under Section 279, 337, 338 of IPC vide order dated

28.01.2020. The accused/applicant did not appear before the learned trial court on 08.10.2021 and therefore notice was issued to the accused/applicant. The accused/applicant did not appear in the court on 04.01.2023 and his bail was cancelled and his bail bond and surety bond were forfeited to the State. Now, the case is fixed in the learned trial court for 01.12.2023 for the presence of the accused. Fresh non-bailable warrant has already been issued against the accused/applicant.

4. The accused/applicant took the plea in the bail application that his maternal uncle has been expired and therefore he could not appear in the court. Though, the reason given by the accused/applicant in the bail application does not seem to be plausible and reasonable, but the trial is lingering due to absence of the accused/applicant. The accused/ applicant is ready to surrender in the learned trial court. Therefore, taking a lenient view, the bail application of the accused/applicant is allowed. The accused/applicant is directed to surrender before learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 15 days from today and the learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate is requested to release the accused-applicant on bail subject to its satisfaction. The accused is also burdened with costs of Rs.500/-, to be deposited in District Legal Service Authority, Fatehgarh Sahib, for wasting the time of the court. Trial Court record be sent back alongwith copy of this order and bail application file be consigned to record room.
