HC Avtar Singh Investigating Officer of this case has made the statement that recovery has already been effected from the applicant-accused and there is no objection if the accused-applicant is ordered to join the investigation. Keeping in view the statement of Investigating Officer HC Avtar Singh, if the accused-applicant is join the investigation within 07 days, he be released on interim bail on furnishing of personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO of concerned Police Station/Investigating Officer concerned subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. i.e (i) the accused-applicant will make himself available for interrogation by the police officer as and when required and will cooperate with the investigating agency, (ii) he will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts (iii) he will not leave India without prior permission of the Court. In case, he does not join the investigation within the above said time, on the expiry of the same, the bail application shall be deemed to be dismissed. The file be consigned to the Record Room.
