	01.12.22	The accused is not in attendance today. Perused the case record. It transpires from the perusal of the case record that it is a case of 2004 and the record is running for appearance of the accused namely Jitendra Kumar. It is evident from record that all the processes including NBW, 82 of CrPC and 83 of CrPC, DO Letter have been issued against the accused. In spite of issuance of all previous coercive processes, the accused person has neither appeared himself nor brought before the court in this case. It appears that the appearance of the accused person cannot be secured in the near future meaning thereby the accused person has not shown respect for legal process having full knowledge of the case. Accordingly considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case the accused namely Jitendra Kumar, is hereby declared <u>absconder</u>. <i>O.C. is directed to issue permanent warrant accordingly and enter the details in absconder register at once.</i> O.C. is further directed to submit the record to the record room with the direction that record should not be destroyed.
