ORDER

Disposal Type: Judgement on admission

A1 present. A1 Counsel present. Food safety officer present. A1 counsel Split up petition filed under the relevant provisions of the Bharathiya Nagarik Suraksh Sanhita, 2023, stating that A2 is absent/not secured and the trial in the mother case is getting delayed. On perusal of records, it is seen that despite steps taken, the presence of the said accused could not be secured. To avoid delay in disposal of the case and in the interest of justice, the petition deserves consideration. Hence the case against A2 is split up from the mother case. A separate case is ordered to be registered and assigned a new STC.No.97/2026. The mother case shall proceed against the remaining accused in accordance with law. Copies furnished U/s 230 B.N.S.S. Petition filed to waive the reflection period and allowed. Substance of accusation explained u/s 274 B.N.S.S. Accused pleaded guilty. Admission petition filed. Materials perused. This court finds that the admission made by A1 is clear and unqualified and the admission of the facts constitutes the offence punishable U/sec.58, 59(i), 63 of Food Safety Act. Further, The accused is sentenced to undergo one day simple imprisonment till the releasing of the court. Hence, the Accused is found guilty for offence U/sec. 58, 59(i), 63 of Food Safety Act and convicted with fine of A1 Rs.15,000/- for offence U/sec.58, 59(i), 63 of Food Safety Act.
