DL-2CAZ-7319 driven rashly and negligently by respondent no.1 Vinay Kumar, owned by respondent no.2 Rohit Kumar and insured with respondent no.3 The Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd.? **OPP**
2. Whether the petitioner is entitled for compensation? If so, to what amount and from whom? **OPP**
3. Relief.
