

Pali Kaur alias Chinto Kaur Vs State of Punjab

Ld. Counsels have appeared through V.C. facility. Police record presented is perused and returned. Heard on this application of applicant for anticipatory bail in this case.

2. Ld. Counsel for applicant submitted that latter has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing is to be recovered from her. There is no previous FIR against her. It is wrongly mentioned that she is running a gang. Applicant however is ready to join the investigation. Hence the prayer to admit her to anticipatory bail.

3. Ld. Addl.P.P. vehemently opposed the bail application submitting that this applicant is an active member of the gang made by the accused party which traps innocent people like complainant in the name of showing saleable plot. Complainant was illegally confined in the house with this applicant by latter's accomplices. Rs.5000/- and purse of complainant were snatched and another Rs.70000/- were demanded from him under threat of facing charges of immoral conduct. Recovery of said purse and of Rs.5000/- is yet to take place. Hence the prayer to dismiss the application.

4. Allegations against applicant are quite serious in nature. As per FIR complainant was illegally confined in a room with this applicant by latter's accomplices where he was taken on pretext to offer tea before showing him a plot. His mobile phone and purse with Rs.5000/- were snatched. Another Rs.70000/-

were demanded from him or he was to face allegations of immoral conduct. That purse and Rs.5000/- are yet to be recovered. Custodial interrogation of applicant hence will be relevant and necessary. For this reason she is not found entitled to anticipatory bail. This bail application is dismissed. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
