ORDER

*I.A.No.III filed by the plaintiff is hereby allowed.
Issue temporary injunction against the defendant as prayed in the IA No.III.*

Defendant, its chief officer, officials, council, agents, subordinates, servants, contractors and all persons claiming under it are hereby restrained from disconnecting, disrupting, obstructing, destroying the

sewage drain pipeline of the plaintiff's business establishments connecting the Municipal liquid waste disposal unit pipeline of the defendant or in any way causing interference to the free flow of sewage drain water thereof till next date of hearing.

Plaintiff is directed to comply the provisions of Order XXXIX Rule 3 of C.P.C.

Issue suit summons, T.I. and notice on I.A.No.III to defendant.
