This order of mine shall dispose of the bail application moved by the applicant/ accused.

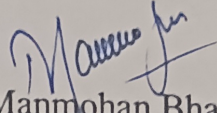
Upon notice, no reply to the application was filed by the prosecution. However, Addl. PP for the State strongly resisted the claim of the applicant and prayed for dismissal of the present application.

After hearing the detailed arguments of Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. APP for the State, this Court is of the considered opinion that the present FIR has been registered against the applicant under Section 458 and 394 of IPC which are grievous in nature and punishable with imprisonment for life. Therefore, this court is of the considered opinion that accused does not deserve any leniency for relief of bail. Hence, accordingly the present application stands dismissed.
