Bail Order

1. This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed on behalf of accused-petitioners Vanjara Ram @ Banjara son of Semi Singh @ Semi Ram, Asha @ Meeta wife of Chhindi and Sunita @ Sapna wife of Vanjara Ram @ Banjara @ Debu for releasing them on bail, in case FIR No.69 dated 19.08.2019, under Section 20/61/85 NDPS Act, Police Station Bajakhana.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State,

which was opposed.

3. Heard. Record received and perused. Perusal of the same shows that total recovery allegedly effected from the possession of accused-petitioners Vanjara Ram @ Banjara, Asha @ Meet and Sunita @ Sapna is 6 kilograms Ganja and such recovery effected from the possession of accused does not fall under commercial quantity, rather the same is non-commercial quantity. Further-more, the accused are in custody since 19.08.2019 and are no more required for further investigation. Moreover, presentation of challan and conclusion of trial is likely to take considerable time. In these circumstances, application in hand is allowed and accused-petitioners **Vanjara Ram @ Banjara, Asha @ Meet and Sunita @ Sapna** are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety of the like amount.

4. Bail/surety bonds not furnished.

5. Papers be attached with the remand-papers, already pending in this court.
