Heard on the bail application filed by accused/applicant Neeraj Arora, wherein it was pleaded that accused is innocent and has not committed any alleged occurrence. It is further averred that applicant/ accused has been falsely implicated in the present FIR under political pressure with an ulterior motive to harass the applicant/accused. It has been further averred that the allegations leveled by the complainant are totally vague, extraneous and baseless. The applicant/ accused is in judicial custody since his arrest. It has been further averred that applicant undertakes to abide by all the terms and conditions, which may be imposed upon her by the court and will not temper with the prosecution evidence. At the end, it has been prayed that accused/applicant is in custody and he be released on bail.

Upon notice, learned APP for the State, appeared and opposed the bail application on the ground that accused have committed serious offence. As such, prayer for dismissal of the present bail application has been made.

I have considered the contradictory versions of the contesting parties and have deliberated over the arguments advanced in the light of documents, peculiar facts and circumstances and submissions made.

Police record as well as original file received and perused. As per police record 14 another FIRs have also been registered at P.S. City-I, Abohar against accused Neeraj Arora. Perusal of the file further reveals that the present FIR has been registered for the commission of offence punishable u/s 420 IPC. From all the allegations leveled in the FIR as well as conduct of

accused, it is apparent that the case relates to cheating for an exorbitant amount being economic offence of high magnitude. Thus, keeping in view the gravity of offence and the conduct of accused, I do not find it appropriate to grant the concession of bail to accused, as such, present bail application stands dismissed and disposed of.
