I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiff proves that the suit schedule property is the joint family property of himself and defendants, they are in joint possession over the same and there is no partition among them as on the date of suit?
2. Whether the plaintiff proves that the gift deed dated 27.05.2020 executed by the defendant No.1 in favour of the defendant No.3 is null and void and not binding on him?
3. Whether the defendant No.3 proves that the suit schedule property is the self acquired property of late Kenchappa @ Fakirappa s/o Kariyappa ?
4. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the partition as sought for ?
5. What order or decree?
