I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiffs proves that themselves and the defendants are constituted a Hindu undivided family?

2. Whether the plaintiffs further proves that the suit properties are joint family properties, thus they became joint owners and in possession of suit properties ?

3. Whether the defendant Nos.1 to 7 proves that the suit properties are self acquired properties of deceased Mallappa S/o Somappa Belligatti and defendant No.2, thus the properties are not available for partition as alleged by the plaintiffs ?

4. Whether the defendant Nos.1 to 7 further proves that suit schedule A-1 property is self acquired property of deceased Mallappa, as such said property not available for partition as claimed by the plaintiffs ?

5. Whether the defendants further proves that suit schedule A-2 property is self acquired property of defendant No.4, defendant No.6 and plaintiff No.2 through their own and independent earnings, hence said property not available for partition as alleged by the plaintiffs ?

6. Whether the defendants further proves that suit schedule B2 property running by defendant Nos.2 and 3 in rented premises investing their own money, carrying huge loan, thus the said factory unit is not available for partition?

7. Whether the defendants further proves that the suit is barred by limitation on the basis of sale deed involved in the suit?

8. Whether the plaintiffs further proves that they are entitled for the reliefs as sought for?

9. What order or decree?
