

**16Bail matters 10/2026,
State vs Ayush Raj

Ld. counsel for the accused has filed an application seeking grant of bail on behalf of applicant/accused namely, Ayush Raj @ Aryan @ Balaji s/o Dhruv Nath Thakur. The IO has filed a reply to the same.

Ld. counsel for accused has submitted that the investigation has been completed qua the applicant. It is further submitted that accused is innocent and falsely implicated and that accused has been languishing in JC since a considerable period and and that no purpose shall be served by detaining the accused in custody any further.

Ld. counsel has prayed that bail be granted to the accused.

Per Contra, Ld. APP has opposed the bail application and has argued that the investigation is at the initial stage and some of the members of syndicate are yet to be apprehended. It is further submitted that considering the nature and gravity of the offence, the bail should be denied.

Heard. Perused. Considered.

As per the prosecution version, the role of accused Ayush Raj @ Aryan @ Balaji s/o Dhruv Nath Thakur is instrumental in the commission of the present offence. The applicant / accused is responsible for opening a forged bank account of complainant in which total receipt of Rs. 6,52,00,000/- (approx) have been received.

Thus, keeping in view the allegations leveled against the accused and considering the nature and gravity of the offence complained of against the accused and further considering the initial stage of

investigation and the fact that other members of the Syndicate are yet to be apprehended, the court does not deem it fit to enlarge the accused Ayush Raj @ Aryan @ Balaji s/o Dhruv Nath Thakur on bail. Hence, the court deems it appropriate to dismiss the instant application without prejudice.
