Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the settled amount of **Rs.2,50,000/-** within **Three months** from the date of award. In case Respondent No.2 fails to pay the amount as stated supra, the said amount shall carry interest at the rate of **6% p.a.** from the date of award till realization.

The compensation amount awarded to the minor petitioner shall be kept in FD in any

liberty to withdraw the same.
