One regular Stenographer is on leave today and substitute stenographer is not available.

Present : Ms. Sandeep Kaur, Ld.Addl. PP for the State.
Ld.Counsel for the applicant/accused.

1. This is an application **u/s 483 BNSS** moved on behalf of the applicant/**accused Gaurav Kumar** seeking **regular bail**.
2. IO has filed reply. Same is taken on record.
3. Arguments heard. Record perused. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused seeks bail for the applicant/accused on the following grounds :- (i) The applicant/accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case; (ii) The applicant/accused is in JC since 07.11.2025; (iii) accused/applicant has no previous criminal involvement; (iv) recovery of alleged arms and ammunition has been planted upon him and it will take considerably long time to conclude the trial and he cannot be kept in JC for an indefinite period.
4. Ld. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the present application and has submitted that the allegations against the applicant/accused are very serious in nature and he may extend any kind of threat to the material public witnesses, if he is released on bail.

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5. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused, Ld. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record. The allegations against the applicant/accused are that on 06/11/25, Hc Sandeep No. 1266/Cr was present in office NR-II/Crime Branch, secret informer arrived at office and informed him that a person, who belongs to UP is engaged in trafficking of illegal arms and ammunition in bulk in Delhi. He further informed that the alleged person will come to Delhi today to supply illegal arms and ammunition near Sector-30, Rohini, Delhi. This information was shared with senior officers and a raiding team comprising, HC Sandeep, HC Pardeep Sheokand, HC Sidhharth, HC Vinod, HC Ashwani and HC Pardeep was constituted, who made departure for the place of information vide GD No. 320A, dated 06/11/25. Further as per above reply, at about 11:00 pm, on the instance of secret informer, one person moving from Mahadev Chowk towards Bawana canal, sector-30, Rohini, Delhi was apprehended, who was carrying a bag pack of black colour. The identity of the alleged person revealed as Gaurav Kumar S/o Ram Gopal r/o Village Dokauli, Tehsil Iglas, Distt. Aligarh, PS-Gonda, UP, Age -27 Yrs. On checking the said bag pack, some clothes were found packed inside it and under the clothes, one brown colour hand bag tied with chain was found and two other plastic bags were also found. Inside the brown coloured bag, 6 semi-automatic pistols, 8 country made pistols, 4 magazines of pistols were found, while in

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one plastic bag 40 live cartridges of 0.32 caliber/bore were found and in another plastic bag, 16 live cartridges of 8 mm were found. The recovered 6 semi-automatic pistols were marked as P-1 to P-6, 8 country made pistols were marked as K-1 to K-8, 4 magazines were marked as M-1 to M-4. Sketches of all the arms and ammunition were prepared on white papers and all were taken into police possession as per seizure memo. Thereafter, the above said case was registered and further investigation of the case was assigned to the undersigned.

6. On specific query, IO submits that PC Remand of the accused was obtained to verify the source of supply of illegal arms and ammunition and accused was taken to District Khargaon, Madhya Pradesh for apprehending co-accused Harpal Singh, who allegedly supplied the arms and ammunition to the accused/applicant. However, he could not be arrested and is still at large. Co-accused Pankaj, who is alleged to be the main source of the supply chain is also yet to be arrested.

7. Huge quantity of illegal arms and ammunition has been recovered from the accused/applicant. Moreover, co-accused who are part of the supply chain are yet to be arrested. The matter is at initial stage before Ld. JMFC as chargesheet has been filed recently. In the above facts and circumstances and in view of nature and gravity of offence, no ground is made out to grant bail to the applicant/accused,

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at this stage. **The present application is accordingly dismissed.**

8. A copy of this order be given *dasti* to Ld. Counsel for the accused and to the IO and be also sent to the Ld. JMFC concerned, Superintendent Jail concerned for information.
