I S S U E S

1. Whether the plaintiffs proves that they themselves and the defendants are the joint family members of Hindu Undivided joint family and suit schedule property is their joint family property ?
2. Whether the defendants proves that in the year 1983 the father of the defendants and their brother partitioned their property and M.E. No.2810 was sanctioned, in the said partition the property bearing R.S. No.493 measuring 13 guntas R.S. No.571 measuring 17 guntas fallen to the share of plaintiffs father, after the death of plaintiffs father by name Shivabasanagouda the plaintiffs have sold the said properties, therefore suit is not maintainable as the property belongs to the defendants father ?
3. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief of partition and separate possession of their $\frac{1}{2}$ share over the suit schedule property ?
4. What order or decree?
