are present, they have filed a Joint-
memo reporting settlement for
amount of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees
Four Lakhs only). The counsel for**

the petitioner submits that they have agreed the terms of compromise and affixed their signature to the Joint Memo. The petitioner and respondent No.2 counsel has made their signature on order sheet as a token of admission of the parties to compromise. Hence, the petition is allowed as to the terms of the Joint-memo.

The respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the said amount within three months from the date of this order. In default said amount shall carry interest at the rate of 6% per annum.

After deposit of the amount by respondent No.2, office is directed to release the amount of Rs.4,00,000/- in favour of petitioner with proper identification through e-payment.
