These petitions are filed U/s.166 of I.M.V. Act seeking compensation in respect of injuries sustained in road traffic accident in Road Traffic Accident which was occurred on 11.12.2022 at about 05-00 a.m Near Doreswami Math Bairanahatti Village, Tq: Naragunda.

The petitions in MVC No.184/2023 and 185/2023 are filed against the respondent in said petitions seeking compensation of Rs.3,50,000/- and 5,50,000/- respectively on account of injuries sustained by the petitioners.

Vide order dated 04-04-2024 passed in M.V.C. No.185/2023, MVC No.184/2023 is clubbed with MVC No.185/2023. In both cases common

evidence has been recorded. For the sake of convenience petitioner in MVC No.184/2023 by name Shivamma W/o Devendrappa Metri is referred to as petitioner No.1 and Shankrappa S/o SheelappaKadagud is referred to as petitioner No.2.

This claim petition coming for final disposal on 9th day of July, 2026 before **Smt. Deepa G. Manerkar**, B.Com., LL.B., (Spl.), II Addl. Senior Civil Judge and Addl., M.A.C.T., Hubballi, in the presence of Sri. B. S. Malipatil, Advocate for petitioner and Sri. A. R. Athani, Advocate for Respondent.

It is ordered and awarded that:

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner U/Sec. 166 of M.V. Act claiming the compensation is hereby partly allowed with costs.

The petitioner No.1 (petitioner in MVC No.184/2023) is entitled to the compensation of Rs.14,616/- and petitioner No.2 (petitioner in MVC No.185/2023) is entitled to the compensation of Rs. 25,096/- with future interest at the rate of 6% p.a., from the date of petition till realization.

The respondent is directed to deposit the award amount before this Tribunal within 3 months.

Since the amount awarded is very meager, on deposit being made entire amount is ordered to be released in favour of the petitioners after proper identification.

Advocate fee is fixed at Rs.500/-.
