These are the two applications, filed U/s 438 Cr.P.C, for grant of anticipatory bail.

Present: Sh. Ram Pyara, Ld. Addl. P.P. for State.

Sh. B.S. Rathore, Ld. Counsel for accused Ayush Sharma.

Complainant Sh. Mohd. Sayeed in his person.

IO SI Ramphool in his person.

Arguments heard.

In this case there are four accused persons, two are absconding.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for accused persons/applicants that the applicants have settled the matter with the complainant and they have made their part of payment to the complainant i.e. accused Arun Sharma and Ayush Sharma have paid Rs.6,00,000/- and Rs.5,00,000/- respectively. It is further added that accused/applicants are ready to join investigation and to give utmost co-operation to the IO as and when asked for by IO or directed by the Court.

Complainant has confirmed about arriving of settlement with the accused/applicants and also about receiving of Rs.6,00,000/- and Rs.5,00,000/- from accused Arun Sharma and Ayush Sharma respectively.

Having heard the submissions and counter submissions of both the sides and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case particularly, the accused/applicants have settled the dispute with the complainant; they are ready to join investigation and to co-operate in the investigation and when asked for by IO or directed by the Court; accused/applicants have roots in the society and they are ready to abide by the condition imposed upon them while

granting the bail, applications of applicants for anticipatory bail are allowed and they are directed to join investigation (in case necessity arises) as and when asked for by the IO by the written notice U/s 160 Cr.P.C and in the event IO feels the necessity of the arrest of accused/applicants, then he will release the accused/applicants on bail subject to furnishing their personal bond in the sum of Rs.40,000/- by each with one surety of the like amount for each to the satisfaction of IO/SHO concerned with further condition that the applicants will not misuse the liberty of bail in any manner, if done so, the prosecution shall be free to file an appropriate application for recalling the order of grant of bail.

With this both the applications stand disposed off.
