V/k filed on behalf of claimants in both the conencted matters.
Copy of untrace report supplied to claimant side.

Father of deceased as well as injured Deepak Jaiswal present in both connected matter and made their separate statement that they have no objection to the untrace report filed by IO. Counsel for claimants also conceded that she has no objection if the untrace report is accepted.

Separate statement of father of deceased in case of Manju Devi Vs. Untrace as well as injured Deepak Jaiswal in his own case titled as Deepak Jaiswal Vs. Untrace recorded to this effect.

As there is no disclosure regarding number of offending vehicle nor any probability of it being located and complainant/ injured also could not note down the particulars of the vehicle, therefore, untraced report is accepted with liberty to the Investigating Officer to initiate investigation as and when any detail about the offending vehicle is traced out.

Accordingly, the case is disposed off as untraced.

At this stage, it may be noted that Sec. 357A (4) Cr.PC states:

Where the offender is not traced or identified,

but the victim is identified, and where no trial takes place, the victim or his dependents may make an application to the State or the District Legal Services Authority for award of compensation.

As such copy of this order be sent DLSA for relief, if permissible, as per law.
