Today I have filed my affidavit in lieu of my chief examination. The contents of the same are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and information. The affidavit bears my signature.

Cross examination for defendants 1 & 2 by Sri.CRP Advocate

Plaintiffs and defendants are the children of my own sister. We are 5 brothers and out of them one has gone in adoption. My father had 180 acres of land. There was a partition in our family about the family properties. In the said partition 45 acres of land was allotted to my share. I have 5 sisters. The partition was effected after the death of my father. It is true that we did not give share to our sisters in the family properties. It is true that I have equal love and affection towards all my nephews. It is true that one of my sister was given to the Nagaraddi family looking to their financial background. I have not produced any documents to show that I purchased 4 Acre 17 guntas of land in RS No.828 in the name of plaintiff Bhimappa out of my own funds. Similarly I have not produced any document to show that I purchased a plot in the name of plaintiff-1 with my funds at Annigeri. I have not produced any documents to show that 8 acre land is purchased out of RS No.581/3 in the name of second plaintiff out of my own funds. It is incorrect to suggest that I am deposing falsely that as the Nagaraddi family was not affluent hence I purchased the

lands in the name of my nephews with my own funds. It is incorrect to suggest that above properties are purchased out of the nucleus of joint family of Nagaraddi. It is incorrect to suggest that to help plaintiff 1 and 2 I am giving false evidence today.
