DHR counsel filed IA No.3 U/s 151 of CPC to direct the SDO of JDR to deduct the amount of present petition from salary of JDR and deposit the same before this court till decree amount is fully satisfied. It is also prayed to close the petition with liberty to file fresh petition in case if order of this court is not complied.

Heard on IA No.3 from DHR counsel. On going through the amount to be paid by JDR is Rs.12,38,570/- and if said amount is deducted from each month salary it will take months together to recover the amount. Till such time the present petition can not be kept pending. As such it is just and necessary to direct the South Western Railway Hubballi i.e., Garnishee to deduct amount from salary of JDR until satisfaction of decree amount. Hence, I proceed to pass the following-

ORDER

IA No.3 filed by DHR U/s 151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

South Western Railway Hubballi is hereby directed to deduct the salary amount from JDR and send the same to the court till the satisfaction of the decree. Further, the DHR is directed to report about the payment to the court after satisfaction of decree. In case if the South Western Railway Hubballi fails to comply the order, the DHR is at liberty to file fresh petition within the period of limitation. Hence, the present petition is closed.
