

Heard Advocate for plaintiffs on I.A. No.I. The suit is for partition and separate possession. I.A. No.I is filed U/o.39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C. seeking temporary injunction against defendants not to alienate or transfer the suit properties either in part or full pending disposal of the suit. Perused the documents produced by the plaintiffs. Plaintiffs claims that they are daughters of deceased Channappa Veerappa Kodli. Perused the documents produced by the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs have produced the documents to show that the suit schedule properties are ancestral properties of plaintiffs and defendants. Hence, plaintiffs have made out prima facie case to grant the temporary injunction. Balance of convenience leans in their favour and if temporary injunction is refused with respect to suit schedule properties, they will be put to hardship. Hence, the following:

ORDER

Defendants are restrained from alienating the suit properties in any manner by granting temporary injunction till next date of hearing.

Issue suit summons and temporary injunction order and notice on I.A. No.I to the defendants.

Plaintiff shall comply the provisions of Order 39 Rule 3A of C.P.C.
