

ORDER ON IA

The Advocate for plaintiff has filed application U/O. 7 R.14(3) of CPC seeking permission of this Court to produce the documents to meets the ends of justice.

Along with application the plaintiff has filed affidavit stating that, she is possessing the original copy of the Sale Deed which will throw light on the matter in dispute between herself and defendant and without producing the same he cannot convince the Court effectively about the grievance caused to them. Hence, he is producing the detailed records of those two properties and prays to allow the application.

The defendant has filed objection denying the averments of application filed by plaintiff and contended that, the plaintiff has filed certified copies of the documents in order to trouble the defendants. Hence, prays to dismiss the application.

Admittedly, the plaintiff has filed suit against the defendants for the relief of partition and separate possession. In the present application, subject to proof of relevancy and admissibility of documents, the plaintiff is permitted to produce the documents. Mere production of documents does not mean that, the documents are proved. The

defendant has right to cross-examine on the alleged documents. Hence, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The application filed by Advocate for plaintiff U/O. 7 R. 14(3) of CPC is hereby allowed.

The plaintiff is permitted to produce the documents.
