

Both parties and counsels are not present.

Perused the plaint valuation and prayer in the plaint, it shows that the plaintiff bank has filed this suit against defendant for recovery of loan amount of Rs.8,86,745.71/- with interest.

The suit valuation made in para no.12 of the plaint reveals that the valuation/claim of the suit is Rs.8,86,745.71 /-.

By virtue of Sec.17 The Karnataka Civil Courts(Amendment) Act 2023 is concerned the jurisdiction of learned Civil Judge Court shall extended for an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- to 15,00,000/- and same is retrospective effect from 28.08.2007. The said amendment has been upheld by the Hon'ble High court of Karnataka Gulbarga Bench in WP No.201536/2024 on 24.09.2025. The said order and amendment Act was upheld Hon'ble High court of Karnataka Bengaluru in WP No.17588/2024 clubbed with W.A 200260/2025 on 08.07.2026 and the special leave petitions(Civil) Dairy No.41602/2026 of Hon'ble Apex Court India dated 03.08.2026. Further by virtue of circular passed by the Honble High court of Karnataka in RJ No.83/2026 dated 01.09.2026 is concerned, the valuation of this suit is come within the jurisdiction of learned Civil Judge Courts of Hubballi. So it is necessary to transfer this case to the learned Prl. Civil Judge and JMFC Hubballi to proceed in accordance with law on same stage.

Office to transfer this case through CIS and send this case file to the above said court immediately. On receiving the same the above said learned court has to register in the concerned suit register as well as in CIS and proceed the matter on same stage i.e., **For framing of issues.**

Accordingly suit is transferred to the learned
Prl. Civil Judge and JMFC Court Hubballi.

appearing for parties are requested to appear before
the above said court on 28.10.2026.
