But, the notice returned as the addressee not found in the given address at the time of serving of notice. Therefore, prima-facie it appears that the Respondent No.18 and 22b have deliberately avoiding court process. As such in the ends of justice the Petitioner is permitted to take substitute service against Respondent No.18 and 22b. Hence, the following;
