Perused the application it is noticed to the court that defendant No.5 is the natural mother acted as guardian on behalf of minor defendant No.6 to 8 and the compromise is in the interest of minors also. Hence application is allowed.

The defendant No.5 is permitted to compromise the matter on behalf of defendant No.6 to 8.

The plaintiffs and defendants are filed the Compromise Petition under Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC duly signed by the parties and counsel. The parties have produced photocopy of their Aadhar Cards by filing memo.
