This is an application u/s 480 BNSS for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant / accused namely Anoop, S/o Sh. Ghanshyam.

Sh. Vikas Sharma, Ld. counsel for applicant / accused.

An application for grant of regular bail u/s 480 BNSS has been filed on behalf of the accused. It is stated in the application that the accused is in judicial custody since 29.03.2026. It is further stated that the accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further stated that investigation in the present case is completed and no purpose shall be served by keeping the accused in custody. It is further stated that accused is the permanent resident of Delhi. It is further stated that the applicant / accused undertakes to furnish sound surety to the satisfaction of this Court.

Reply has been filed by the IO. It is stated that accused is involved in more than 20 criminal cases and he may tamper with evidence or commit similar offences, if granted bail.

Submissions have been heard. Record perused.

The present FIR pertains to offences u/s 305/331(3)/317(2)/3(5) BNS. From the report of the IO, the investigation of the case appears to be substantially complete. Case property has been recovered. The object of bail is to secure the presence of the accused during

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trial and not to punish him before conviction. Pre-trial detention must not assume a punitive character. The investigation is over and trial is likely to take considerable time, therefore keeping the applicant further in incarceration will not serve any fruitful purpose. There are many previous criminal involvements reported for the accused. This court is of the considered opinion that accused can be admitted to bail subject to certain conditions.

The accused Anoop, S/o Sh. Ghanshyam is hereby admitted to bail subject to the following conditions :-

- (i) the accused shall furnish bail bonds for a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- along-with one surety of the like amount;
- (ii) the accused shall not contact / attempt to contact the complainant or any other witness in any manner whatsoever; and
- (iii) the accused shall furnish his active mobile number to the IO / SHO, PS Mehrauli forthwith and shall keep the same active / switched on at all times.

The application stands allowed and disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
