The suit schedule property is VPC No.275. There is a house, backyard and a provision store in the said suit property. The said property stands in the name of my wife. I have executed a Relinquishment deed in favour of my wife regarding the suit property. The suit schedule property is inherited by me from my parents.

2. My grandfather's name is Doddabasappa. My grandfather had 4 sons by name Bharamappa, Ramappa, Channappa and Gulappa. The suit schedule property was purchased in the year 1945. The suit schedule property was measuring 8 Guntas. It is false to suggest that, the 4 guntas of the suit schedule property was given to Bharamappa and Ramappa. The witness voluntarily states that the 4 guntas of the suit schedule property was given to Bharamappa. It is false to suggest

that, the remaining 4 guntas of the suit schedule property was partitioned between the defendants' father Channappa and myself.

3. I now see a document shown to me which is already marked as Ex.P.7(a). It is false to suggest that, as per Ex.P.7(a) the defendants' father and myself had divided 4 guntas suit schedule property at the rate of 2 guntas each.

4. I am in knowledge of the statement of objection filed by the plaintiff at Gram Panchayath on 16.01.2012 disputing the entering made in the Panchayath records of the suit schedule property. I have the knowledge regarding the endorsement issued by Gram Panchayath, Bhogenagarakoppa dated 22.09.2022 and marked as Ex.P.5.

5. One Mallappa and Ramesh are in possession of the property in VPC No. 208/3 (property nonsuited). The witness voluntarily states there are 3 persons in possession of the property in VPC No. 208/3. It is false to suggest that, I have made a Relinquishment Deed in favour of my wife with an intention to avoid 2 guntas of the suit property being given to the plaintiff.
