It is submitted on behalf of the prosecution that the witness could not be summoned for today and the proceedings for ascertaining the Designated Place at the Remote Point could not be completed as certain further information has been sought by the Canadian Authorities.

IO has also moved an application apprising the Court regarding the said facts and the information sought by the Canadian Authorities. Copy supplied to the Ld. Counsel for the accused persons.

Vide order dated 13.05.2026, my Ld. Predecessor has already permitted recording of the testimony of LW-11 Sh. Vimal Singh through Video Conferencing. By virtue of the present application, it is informed that the Remote Point and the

Designated Place for recording the evidence and the Coordinator at the Remote Point could not be appointed as certain further information has been sought by the Canadian Authorities. Copy of the relevant email and other correspondence are also annexed with the application moved by the IO.

Ld. Counsel for accused submits that he does not wish to file any written reply to the present application and accused persons have no objection, if further time is granted. Hence, the present application is allowed. The concerned IO is directed to provide the necessary information as per rules and intimate the Court regarding the Remote Point, Designated Place and the Coordinator appointed at least five working days prior to the next date of hearing. Further, the witness shall be also summoned in terms of the order dated 13.05.2026 and the matter be listed for recording the testimony of LW-11 Sh. Vimal Singh through Video Conferencing on **18.11.2026 at 11:00 AM**.

It is further intimated that the witness is well versed with english language and there will be no requirement of the Translator.

The IO further requests that in order to expedite the proceedings an intimation/letter of request be also issued from this Court to the Ministry of Home Affairs.

Heard. Allowed.

As per the Rule No. 9.(4).1 of the Rules, when the person to be examined is overseas, the Remote Point Coordinator shall be an official of Indian Consulate/the relevant Indian Embassy or the relevant High Commission of India. Accordingly, a letter of request be sent to the Ministry of Home Affairs for

facilitating appointing a Coordinator as per the Rules 9.(4).1 of the Rules and to make the necessary arrangements to enable the witness to join the video conferencing for recording his/her testimony.

A letter of request be sent to the Ld. Officer-In-Charge, Video Conferencing Room, Rouse Avenue District Court, thereby requesting to direct the concerned official to ensure the availability of the Video Conferencing Room and to make all necessary arrangements well in advance for recording of the evidence of the witness on the date and time fixed.
