

## **ORDER ON IA NO.1 and 2**

The petitioner has filed the present applications U/Sec.144(1) and 144(2) of BNSS against respondent for interim maintenance and for medical assistance.

### **2. The brief fact of the case are as under:**

The petitioner submits that, her marriage with respondent held on 15.02.2015 in Baad village, Shiggaon taluka as per Hindu rituals.

**3.** She further submits that, during her marriage with respondent her parents incurring huge expenses and towards varopachara gave 10 tholas of gold, Rs.1,00,000/- cash and Rs.10,000/- valuing cloths.

**4.** She further submits that, she has led her matrimonial life with respondent only for 4 to 5 year. Later, the respondent was harassing her physically and mentally by demanding further dowry from her parents. The respondent use to scold her in abusive language and use to assault her and also use to keep her on fasting. She with a hope that one or other day her life will be set right use to tolerate all the acts of respondent.

**5.** She further submits that, later the respondent use to quarrel with petitioner saying that you have no issues and you are infertile and unable to give birth a child, give me your signature and I will marry another women for which she did not agree and he under the said guise use to assault physically and

caused mental harassment to her. He has also not provided medical assistance to her.

**6.** She further submits that, the respondent is having agricultural land in Baad Village, Shiggaon taluka in Re. Sy. No.88/3 measuring 04 acres, 30 guntas he is drawing Rs.4,00,000/- per year. The respondent is also having Dairy farming and getting annual income of Rs.2,00,000/-, in spite of that he has neglected her by not providing her with day to day legal necessities. She is unable to maintain herself by meeting her day to day expenses, as such has prayed for interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/- towards the monthly maintenance.

**7.** Heard and perused.

**8.** The petitioner submits that, her marriage with respondent held on 15.02.2015 in Baad village, Shiggaon taluka as per Hindu rituals. She has further alleged that, the respondent in spite of having sufficient source to taking care of her has shown his negligent attitude towards her. On careful perusal of application averments the petitioner at this stage has made out sufficient grounds to claim interim maintenance and also medical assistance. It is just and necessary for this Court to consider the interest of petitioner. Hence, holding there are prima-facie grounds made out by the petitioner, this Court proceeds to pass the following.

**ORDER**

Pending disposal of applications filed by petitioner U/Sec.144(1) and 144(2) of BNSS. Respondent is directed to pay Rs.2,000/- to the petitioner towards the monthly interim maintenance and Rs.1,000/- towards the medical assistance of the petitioner until further orders by this court.

Issue notice to respondent returnable by: 02.09.2024.
