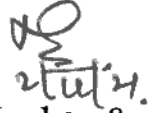

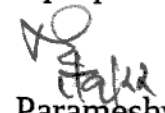

ADDITIONAL ISSUES DATED: 01-09-2022

- 1) Whether the suit is properly valued and paid correct court fee?
- 2) Whether the Defendant No.10, 12 and 14 to 17 prove that the plaintiff and defendant No. 6 and 7 have no share in the suit schedule properties as sufficient dowry and Varopachara given and marriage performed by spending huge amount at the time of their marriage?
- 3) Whether the defendant No. 10, 12 and 14 to 17 prove that the defendant No. 11 (a) has entered into compromise in O.S. No.57/1993 on file of Civil Judge and JMFC., Kundgol by receiving Rs. 80,000/- as his ½ share?
- 4) Whether the defendant No. 10, 12 and 14 to 17 prove that the suit is hit by principle of Res-judicate?
- 5) Whether defendant No. 13 proves that the compromise decree obtained in O.S. 57/1993 is not binding on her?
- 6) Whether defendant No. 13 is entitled for counter claim?
- 7) Whether defendant No. 10 and 12 to 17 prove that the suit is bad for non joinder of necessary parties and non inclusion of other properties?
