This petition is filed under Section 13-(1) (ia)(ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking the Court to dissolve the marriage between the petitioner and respondent which was held on 8.4.2012 at Kambadur village and Mandal of Ananthapuramu District, by way of divorce on the grounds of cruelty and desertion.

A fixed court fee of Rs.10/- is paid and under schedule-II of Article-I (VII) of A.P.C.F., and S.V.Act.

The Cause of action for the petition arose on 4.8.2012 at Kambadur village and Mandal, when the marriage of the petitioner was performed with the respondent and the respondent subjected the Petitioner to cruelty physically and mentally and necked out from his house without any reasons on the part of the petitioner in the month of June 2019 and deserted her about three years back without any reasonable cause and the respondent has no willingness or desire to lead marital life with her and the respondent is residing at Kambaduru village and mandal within the jurisdiction of the court and all are within the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court.

This petition came before me on 22.12.2023 for final hearing in the presence of Sri M.Mahesh Kumar advocate for the petitioner and the of Sri G.Srikanth advocate for the respondent and upon the matter having stood over for consideration till this day, and this court doth order and decree as follows :-

- i) That the marriage between the petitioner and respondent held on 4.8.2012 is dissolved by decree of divorce, by way of mutual consent.
- ii) That there is no order as to costs.
