Learned counsels present on behalf of both the parties argued for settlement of issues. They are heard. The parties are advised to opt any mode of settlement prescribed by Section 89 of CPC for the settlement of their dispute. Learned counsel present on behalf of both the parties stated at bar that there is no possibility of settlement of dispute through any mode of ADR. Therefore, let the case be decided on merits.

From the pleadings of parties, following issues are hereby settled down:-

1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for decree for declaration, as prayed for?OPP.
2. Whether the suit of the plaintiff is non-maintainable in the present form?OPD.
3. Relief.

No other issue is pressed or claimed. If there is any other issue the same stands waived. Now to come up on **03.09.2026** for evidence of the plaintiff. Witnesses be summoned on filing of PF/DM/list of witnesses within seven days. Examination in chief of the private witnesses shall be in the shape

of affidavits. Copies of affidavits of the witness be furnished to the opposite counsel well in advance. If the copies of the such affidavit(s) be not supplied to the opposite counsel or supplied on the date fixed then the party who supplied the same or the party who is at fault then the said party shall be burdened with costs as the court deems fit.
