*In-pursuance of the conciliation, both counsels submit compromise petition U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC. Copy of adhar card of all parties is filed enclosed with memo.*

*On perusal of the said compromise petition it is stated that, one Virupakshappa is the*

*propositus of the family. D1 is his widow. They have begotten plaintiff and D2 to 4.*

*The suit properties are standing in the name of plaintiff, D1 and D 3 and are joint family properties purchased by the propositus and now succeeded by the parties wherein the parties have pre-existing right in the suit schedule properties.*

*The D-1, D-2 and D-4 have relinquished their share in the suit properties and other parties have acquired share as per the terms of compromise petition & hand sketch annexed therewith.*

*The terms of compromise is read over and explained to the parties. They are enquired and they admit the correctness of the contents of compromise petition after it was read over and explained to them. The relinquishment is voluntary. Since, the terms of compromise are lawful, the same is acceptable. Hence the following :*

#### **ORDER**

*The compromise petition filed U/o 23 Rule 3 of CPC is accepted and allowed.*

*Suit is decreed in terms of compromise.*

*The terms of compromise and hand sketch annexed therewith shall form part of compromise decree.*

*Parties shall be bound by the charges created over the property.*

*Office to draw decree accordingly.*
