Plaintiffs and defendants are present and their counsel are present. They submitted that, the parties have arrived into compromise.

They have filed the compromise petition U/o XXIII Rule 3 CPC. I perused the same. On Perusal the same, this court is of opinion that, the compromise is in the interest of parties. The terms of the compromise petition are explained to all parties in the language known to them and they admit the correctness. They understood the same. The compromise appears to be lawful one and not against the public policy. Hence I proceed to pass the following.

ORDER

The petition filed U/o XXIII Rule 3 of C.P.C is hereby allowed.

The suit of plaintiffs is decreed according to terms of Compromise and as such Compromise petition is accepted.

Compromise petition shall be part and parcel of compromise decree.

Office is directed to draw decree as per the compromise petition.
