Suit parties are present and they file compromise petition U/o.23 Rule 3 of CPC seeking drawing of decree in terms of compromise.

Suit parties submit that they have compromised the dispute and as such they entered into compromise in terms of instant petition.

The plaintiff has instituted the present suit seeking relief of Partition and Separate Possession. Considering the oral submission of suit parties and contents of compromise petition, this Court is of the opinion that the compromise sans any force, undue influence and misrepresentation but, voluntary. Therefore, we incline to accept the compromise petition. Hence, we proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

Compromise petition filed by the suit parties U/o.23 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Office is hereby directed to draw up final decree in terms of compromise petition.

The compromise petition shall form part and parcel of decree.
