Vide this order, this Court shall dispose off the application moved by accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) seeking issuance of no objection for a fresh passport.

This is an application filed on behalf of the applicant/ accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) seeking issuance of no objection from this Court for issuance of a fresh passport. It is averred in the application that the applicant had applied for issuance of a fresh Indian Passport before the Regional Passport Office and during the processing of the application, the Passport Authority informed the applicant that in view of the pendency of the present criminal case, a No Objection Certificate/ Permission Order from this Court is required. It is submitted that the issuance of a fresh passport would not prejudice the pending trial in any manner nor would it adversely affect the administration of justice. Thus, it is prayed that a No Objection be issued in favour of the applicant for issuance of a fresh passport.

Reply has been filed by the CBI wherein the application has been opposed on the ground that grant of a No

Objection Certificate for issuance of a fresh passport would increase the possibility of the accused leaving the jurisdiction of this Court, thereby jeopardizing the progress of trial and frustrating the administration of justice. Copy of reply supplied to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

Perusal of the bail order dated 08.07.2015 passed by the Ld. Predecessor of this Court, reveals that the applicant/ accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) was granted bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount. There is nothing on record which suggest that there has been any misuse of bail by the applicant/ accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61). Thus, no prejudice would be caused to the CBI if applicant/accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) gets a fresh passport issued in his name.

In view of the same, this Court has no objection in issuance of a fresh passport to the applicant/ accused by the Passport Authority as per rules.

It is clarified that this order is not a direction to the passport authorities to issue the passport to the applicant/ accused. It is also clarified that this order should also not be construed as recommendation of the Court to Passport Authority. This order is only a 'No Objection' of this Court to consider the application of applicant/ accused for issuance of a fresh passport to applicant/ accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) as per rules.

Needless to say, the applicant/ accused Manish Kumar Singh (A-61) shall not leave the country without prior permission of this Court.

Application bearing **IA No. 03/2026** is accordingly disposed off as allowed.
