Statement of serving police official HASI Subhash Chander No.411, Summons Branch, SP Office Dharamshala, recorded in respect of service of accused No.1 by way of proclamation. Statement of HHC Anil No.544, Summons Branch Dharamshala regarding service of accused No.2 by way of proclamation has already been recorded.

As per statement and report of serving police official HASI Subhash Chander No.411, one copy of the proclamation was affixed and read over on the house of accused No.1 namely Sucharu Bedi on 28.01.2026 and another copy was affixed on the front boundary wall of Rajkiya Uch Vidyala, located in the residential area of accused No.1 and the same was read over to the persons present there on the same day. A copy of the proclamation was affixed on the notice board of this Court on 24.02.2026.

Further, as per statement and report of serving police official HHC Anil No.544, one copy of the proclamation was affixed and read over on the house of accused No.2 namely Tamana Bedi on 22.12.2025 and another copy was affixed on the cross road leading to the house of accused No.2 and the same was read over to the persons present there on the same day. A copy of the proclamation was affixed on the notice board of this Court on 25.12.2025.

Accused persons were required to appear before the Court on 28.03.2026. Therefore, a period of more than 30 days has expired between service of accused persons by way of proclamation under Section 82 Cr.P.C. and date fixed for hearing in the Court. Accordingly, accused persons are hereby declared to be proclaimed persons. Ld. counsel for the complainant stated at

bar that he does not intend to lead any evidence under Section 299 Cr.P.C.

Let, a copy of this order be sent to SHO, P.S. Dharamshala with direction to produce the accused before this Court as and when they are apprehended. Record of this Court after due completion be consigned to the record room.
