2. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, plaintiff No. 2 to 4 received the 10 tolas gold and 100 tola silver as per the said partition?
3. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, the plaintiff No. 1 use to take rents and deposits of the property as stated in the WS?
4. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, suit of the plaintiff is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties and non-inclusion of all the joint family properties in the suit?
5. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, CTS No.1635/27 was allotted to the share of defendant No. 4 but plaintiff No.1 sold the said property to perform the marriage of plaintiff No.2.?

6. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, as per partition took place in the year 1976 is 60 tola gold and 100 tola silver was allotted to the share of defendant No.4 but plaintiff No.1 received the said movable as minor guardian?
7. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, plaintiffs are relinquish their rights by receiving amount of Rs.4,00,000/- from him?
8. Whether the defendant No.4 proves that, the plaintiff No.1 wrongly mentioned the date of birth of defendant No.4, to showing that, he was a major at that time and execute the sale deed?
