::ORDERS ::**Orders on petition filed Under order 20 Rule 18 of CPC**

1. It is case of the petitioners that, they have filed the O.S.No.297/2023 for relief of partition and separate possession, the said suit is came to be decreed on 27-04-2024, Accordingly, the petitioners are entitled to 1/10th share each in the R.Sy. 23/1P, measuring 2 acre 38 and R.Sy.No. 115/5, measuring 0-25 guntas situated at Kurahatti village. No appeal is pending against the Judgment and Decree of O.S.No.297/2023 Hence, pray for appointment of Court Commissioner and demarcate the share of petitioner.

2. As per direction of apex court the suo-moto petition was registered against the respondent. But no one has appeared and filed objection.

3. After considering the judgment and decree, this court has appointed ADLR Ron commissioner for landed properties suit schedule properties in terms of decree. The ADLR Ron has demarcated the decree properties and submitted the report. On the other hand petitioner has submitted no objection to Commissioner report.

4. Heard on petitioner side.

5. On considering the facts and circumstances of the case, after considering the commissioner reports in order to meet ends of justices and equity, it is just and necessary to allot the following properties to the petitioner as follows.

**The property bearing R.Sy.No.23/1 P
divided into 6 parts out of which Part-I is
allotted plaintiff No.1, Part-II is allotted to
plaintiff No.2, Part-III is allotted to plaintiff
No.3, Part-IV is allotted to plaintiff No.4.
Part-V is allotted to defendant No.2 and Part-
VI is allotted to defendant No.1.**

**In R.Sy.No. 115/5 divided into 6 parts
out of which Part-I is allotted plaintiff No.1,
Part-II is allotted to plaintiff No.2, Part-III is
allotted to plaintiff No.3, Part-IV is allotted to
plaintiff No.4. Part-V is allotted to defendant
No.2 and Part-VI is allotted to defendant No.1.**

**The commissioners reports shall be
part and parcel of the final decree.**
