

Amarjit Singh Vs State of Punjab CRM-208-2026

Present: Sh. K.S. Bhogal Advocate counsel for applicant.

Ld. APP for the State.

This order of mine shall dispose of an application for releasing the bearing no. PB-23-W-4372.

2. It is averred in the application that the police of PS Sadar Rajpura has registered an FIR no. 015 dated 09.03.2026 u/s 281, 106(1) BNS at PS Sadar Rajpura. It is further stated that the abovesaid vehicle is no more required by the police station. At last, prayed that application be allowed.

3. Notice of the application given to Ld. APP for the State. However the present application was not contested by Ld. APP for the State.

4. Report of IO received and perused. As per the report it is stated that the vehicle bearing no. PB-23-W-4372 is registered in the name of Amarjit Singh son of Baldev Singh. It is further stated that police has no objection if the said vehicle in question is released on sapurdari to the registered owner.

5. Heard. In view of the report submitted by IO concerned, this court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the vehicle in question for indefinite period as the challan in this case is yet to be presented and conclusion of trial would take considerable time. Accordingly, application moved by the applicant for release of vehicle in question of sapurdari is allowed on furnishing of sapurdari bonds of Rs. 15,000/- with one surety in the like amount with the conditions;

1. The applicant shall produce the vehicle in the court as and when he will be required by the court to produce it.

2. The applicant shall not sell the vehicle to any other person till the final decision of the court.

3. The applicant shall not change the colour of the vehicle.

6. The sapurdari property be released forthwith to the applicant. SHO/ IO is directed to click the coloured photographs of the said vehicle

clearly indicating its conditions and the cabinet size prints of the photographs shall be appended along with challan as and when presented in the court. With these observations, the present application stands disposed of.

Sapurdari bonds and surety bonds not furnished.
