

ORDERS ON THE IA NO. 3

It is seen that the decree was in favour of the plaintiff, in OS No. 331/1998 vide judgment and decree dated 16/4/2004, where the defendants were directed to hand over the possession of the suit properties VPC No. 153 and VPC 218 of Sandigawada village.

The DHR has filed application for handing over the possession of the properties through a special bailiff.

It is seen that RA 9/2005 was filed which was dismissed and against that the said judgment , RSA No.2487/2005 was filed and the same was dismissed on 17/3/2021.

The JDR No. 2 and 10 have appeared through the advocate, but no objection is filed.

Hence the objection is taken as not filed.

IT is seen that the plaintiff has taken a decree and in order to reap the fruits of the decree, he needs to be given the possession of the suit properties, vide the order of the trial court.

Hence the following :

ORDER

The Special Bailiff is appointed for the purpose of handing over the possession of the suit properties at Sandigawada village.

The bailiff shall carry the work in the presence of the PDO of the concerned Panchayath.

Also he is directed to file a report to the said extent.
