Perusal of the record shows that the present petition is
an objection petition under Section 34 of the Arbitration and
Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking setting aside of the Arbitral
Award dated 13.01.2021 passed by the Deputy Commissioner,
Sirsa. However, the petition has been registered as Land
Acquisition matter. Ahlmad is directed to get the same registered
as an Arbitration matter and update the same in the CIS.

As per Ahlmad report, original Arbitration Award
proceedings has been received and attached in ARB-153-2025.

Since respondents no. 1 to 3 have not appeared or their
counsel is not present today and this case has been received by
way of transfer, therefore, by way of abundant caution, let court
notice be issued to counsel for respondents no. 1 to 3, returnable
for 21.05.2025.

It has also come to my notice that the Arbitrator who
had passed the impugned Award has not been made party in the
present petition. Therefore, the Arbitrator-cum-the then, Deputy
Commissioner, Sirsa be impleaded as respondent no.5 and
amended title be filed.
