

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

1] Perused complaint, affidavit and documents produced on record. Perused affidavit of the complainant in respect of transaction. Heard complainant and complainant's advocate. It is alleged that accused issued cheque for legal liability and debt. On presentation of cheque by complainant for clearance, it came to be dishonoured. Thereafter, complainant issued statutory demand notice to accused within 30 days from the dishonour of cheque and called accused to make payment within 15 days of the receipt of notice. However, accused after due service of notice and its acknowledgment failed to comply the notice.

2] In view of submissions made on behalf of the complainant it is noticed that the complainant has complied with statutory requirements. The complaint appears to be well within limitation and jurisdiction of this Court. There are sufficient grounds to proceed against accused for the issuance of process. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

- i) Issue process against accused vide Section 204 of Cr. P. C. or 227 of BNSS for the offence P. U. Sec. 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
- ii) Complainant to pay the process fee, if not paid already.
- iii) Service by all legal Modes allowed.
